My mind and body have suffered immense trauma since experiencing serious domestic violence. I had fear, anxiety, palpitations, and insomnia. Over time, I realized that if I did not ask for help, it would destroy my physical and mental health. So I called Womankind's helpline. I meet with my advocate every week. With her firm support, I believe I will be able to get out of the shadows, recover everything I lost, and rebuild my life!

My mind has been caught up in so many things: keeping my children safe, looking for an apartment and a job, going to appointments with my attorneys and to court. Life has been so hectic that I almost can't remember when was the last time I had this much fun with my girls. Thanks to Womankind's Summer Recreational Program for children, we had water fights in the park, leaving everything behind for a moment. Their smiles and laughter remind me of what I am fighting for and keep me going. I cannot give up.

OUR MISSION Womankind works with survivors of gender-based violence to rise above trauma and build a path to healing. We bring critical resources and deep cultural competency to help survivors of all ages in Asian communities find refuge, recovery, and renewal from domestic violence, human trafficking, and sexual violence.

THE IMPACT OF YOUR DOLLAR

\$150

facilitates one woman's participation in four weeks of sessions at Womankind's Asian Women Empowerment Program for holistic wellness.

\$500

provides counseling and practical assistance to a family.

\$1,000

houses a family in Peace House or Rose House, our emergency residences, for a week.

\$1,500

enables a woman to attend a NYS-certified vocational program that will provide her the specialized skills and certification she needs to earn a living wage.

\$7,000

empowers a woman with two children in our Transitional Housing Program to secure her own apartment for a year.

\$10,000

provides 10 women with economic empowerment workshops and training, professional attire, and/or a mobile device to support her employment.
